

This document provides a summary of performances in Common Admission Test (CAT) 2006, past academics and profile of all candidates who applied for PGP 2007- 09 at IIMB and those who have been short-listed for the group discussion and personal interview for the above programme.

76700 candidates appeared for CAT 2006 held on November 19, 2006. Out of them, 171709 have applied for IIMB PGP. The following excerpts are taken from the CAT Bulletin, which describes the process of selection at IIM Bangalore for the PGP:

Candidates are short listed for the interview on the basis of their performance in the Common Admission test (CAT), their scholastic record and relevant work experience. ...The CAT score is but one of the inputs at every stage of the selection process. It is possible for a candidate with a lower CAT score to be selected for interview and group discussion, and to be offered admission in preference to a candidate with a higher CAT score on account of better performance in other criteria mentioned above."

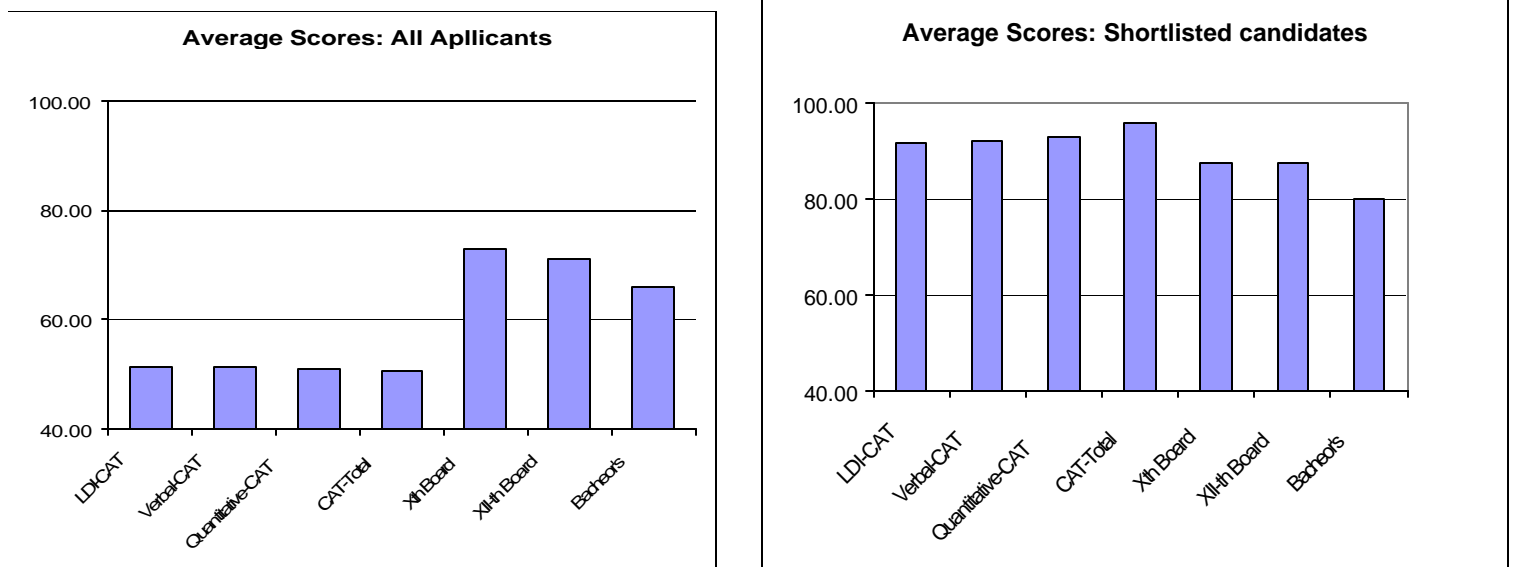

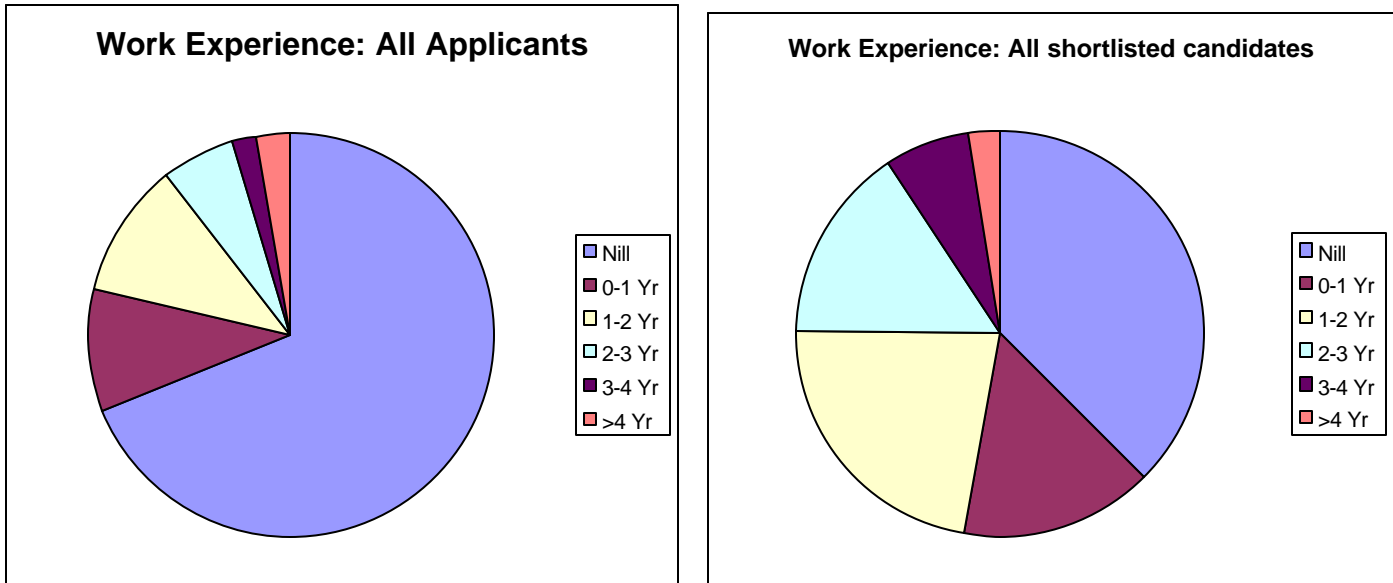
